Separate sealed bids clearly marked will be received by the Department of Public Works, 2 Oakmont Avenue, Westminster MA 01473 until Thursday, July 16, 2020 at 11:00 a.m., at which time they will be publicly opened and read via teleconference by calling (978) 990-5242 and entering access code 727982. Bid packages may be obtained from the Department of Public Works, 2 Oakmont Avenue, Westminster, MA 01473. The Town of Westminster reserves the right to accept or reject, in whole or in part, any or all bids, and to take whatever other action deemed necessary to be in the best interest of the Town.

1.) Submittal Deadline and Format:

Sealed bids must be submitted by 11:00 a.m., Thursday, July 16, 2020 to the Department of Public Works at the above address. Postmarks and faxed bids will not be considered. One original and two copies of the bid, prepared in accordance with the Submittal Requirements listed in Section 2, below, must be submitted in a sealed envelope indicating the firm's name and address. The envelope must be marked in the lower left-hand corner as follows:

2.) Submittal Requirements

All bids shall contain the following completed attachments and additional information:

3.) Time for Award

All bid prices submitted in response to this IFB must remain firm for thirty (30) days following the bid opening. A contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder within thirty (30) days of the opening of bids. The time for award may be extended for up to 14 additional days by mutual agreement between the Town and the apparent lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

4.) Pre-Bid Conference

5.) Right to Cancel/Reject Bids:

The Town reserves the right to cancel this Invitation for Bids (IFB), to reject any and all bids, wholly or in part, to waive informalities when in the best interest of the Town, and to make awards in a manner deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.

6.) General Requirements

- a) The bidder shall be bound by all applicable statutory provisions of the laws of the Federal Government, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and the Town of Westminster.
- b) This bid must cover all contingencies, including all labor, materials, transportation, etc., necessary for the delivery of these supplies as required by the Town of Westminster.
- c) The procurement officer shall unconditionally accept a bid without alteration or correction, except as provided in this paragraph. A bidder may correct, modify, or withdraw a bid by written notice received in the office designated in the IFB prior to the time and date set for the bid opening. After bid opening, a bidder may not change the price or any other provision of the bid in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the governmental body or fair competition. The procurement officer shall waive minor informalities or allow the bidder to correct them. If a mistake and the intended bid are clearly evident on the face of the bid document, the procurement officer shall correct the mistake to reflect the intended correct bid and so notify the bidder in writing, and the bidder may not withdraw the bid. A bidder may withdraw a bid if a mistake is clearly evident on the face of the bid document but the intended correct bid is not similarly evident.
- d) Before submitting a bid, each bidder must make a careful study and fully assure itself of the requirements of this IFB. By signing and submitting its bid, the bidder agrees to all terms and conditions of this IFB, including but not limited to the specifications and contract terms.
- e) Bid Deposits: If the Invitation for Bid requires a bid deposit, such deposit shall be submitted in the form of cash, bid bond, cashier's check, treasurer's heck, or certified check on a responsible bank, payable to the Town of Westminster, and must be filed with the original bid. Failure to do so will lead to rejection of the bid. The bid deposit will be returned to the successful bidder within seven (7) days of execution of award and approval by the Town of any performance and/or payment bond(s). In case of default, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to the Town.
- f) Performance and/or Payment Bonds: If so stated in the Invitation for Bid, the Contractor will be required to furnish a performance and/or a labor and material payment bond in an amount, in a form and with a surety satisfactory to the Town. The bidder shall be responsible for the cost of the bond(s).
- g) The successful bidder will be required to enter into a contract with the Town substantially as shown in Attachment C.
- h) The bidder will be required to indemnify the Town for all damage to life and property that may occur due to its negligence or that of its employees, subcontractors, etc., during the period of this project (included in Form of Contract, Att. C).
- i) Purchases made by the Town of Westminster are exempt from the payment of Federal Excise Taxes and Massachusetts Sales Taxes and any such taxes must not be included in the quoted price(s).

- j) All questions concerning this IFB and requests for interpretation of these documents shall be submitted in writing to the Procurement Officer no less than five (5) business days before the due date for submissions. Written responses will be mailed, faxed or emailed to all bidders on record as having picked up/received the IFB.
- k) If it becomes necessary to revise any part of this IFB or if additional data is necessary to enable an exact interpretation of provisions, such addenda will be provided to all firms that have requested this IFB. No addenda will be issued within the immediate three (3) business days prior to the bid deadline. If an addendum is issued, all bidders shall acknowledge receipt of each addendum with their bid.
- The successful bidder shall maintain such insurance as will protect it from claims under Workmens' Compensation Acts and from any other claims for property damage or personal injury, including death, which may arise from operations under this contract.
- m) The right of the successful bidder to proceed may be terminated at any time by the Town if it is determined that the bidder, the bidding firm, or its agent(s) offered or gave a gratuity to an employee of the Town of Westminster in order to obtain a contract or receive favorable treatment under a contract. The contractor shall certify by the execution of bid documents that the bid is rendered independently, without fraud, collusion or in connection with any other bidder and that no official or employee of the Town of Westminster is pecuniarily interested in the solicitation of any resultant contract.
- n) In the event that the Town receives low quotes/bids in identical amount from two or more responsive and responsible bidders, the Town shall select the successful bidder by a blind selection process such as flipping a coin or drawing a name from a hat. The low bidders who are under consideration will be invited to attend and
- o) The contract is effective when signed by both the Contractor and the Town, and shall extend for a period of one year. At the Town's sole discretion, this contract may be extended for two additional one year terms at the same contract price, terms and conditions.

III. PURCHASE DESCRIPTION/SPECIFICATIONS/ SCOPE OF SERVICES

Description

- (a) The bidder shall supply Hot Mix Asphalt, Laid in Place to the Town of Westminster in accordance with the Invitation For Bid and this Specification. The bidder shall not subcontract any portion of this contract. The work to be done under this item shall consist of all the operations and furnishing all the materials, labor and equipment necessary to supply Hot Mix Asphalt, Laid in Place. The project quantity of Hot Mix Asphalt, Laid in Place is 10,000 TONS (Superpave 9.5 & 12.5mm Top, 19.0 & 37.5mm Binder). The bidder understands that the quantities stated are approximate and should not be interpreted as the actual quantities the Town will purchase or be committed to purchase.
- (b) All work under this contract shall be done in conformance with the Massachusetts Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highways and Bridges dated 1988, the Supplemental Specifications dated July 1, 2015, and the Interim Supplemental Specifications contained in this contract; the 2016 Construction Standard Details, the 1990 Standard Drawings for Signs and Supports; the 1996 Construction and Traffic Standard Details (as relates to the Pavement Markings details only); The 2015 Overhead Signal Structure and Foundation Standard Drawings, the 2009 Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) with Massachusetts Amendments and the Standard Municipal Traffic Code; the 1968 Standard Drawings for Traffic Signals and Highway Lighting; the latest edition of American Standard for Nursery Stock; the LRFD Bridge Manual 2013 Edition; AASHTO Guide for the Planning, Design, and Operation of Pedestrian Facilities, 1st Edition; The Guide for the Development of Bicycle Facilities 2012 Edition, the Plans and these Special Provisions.

The pavement shall be in accordance with Section 450 Quality Assurance for Hot Mix Asphalt and Section 455 Superpave Asphalt Hot Mix Specifications.

(c) Pneumatic Tired Roller

A PNEUMATIC TIRED ROLLER IS <u>REQUIRED</u> for all intermediate rolling on this project. Three rollers will be required for this project with the pneumatic tired roller being used between the breakdown roller and the finish roller. The pneumatic tired roller shall not be used as a breakdown roller. In addition to compaction, the purpose of this roller will be to provide a more tightly-knit, traffic resistant surface.

(d) Segregation

Paving operations shall be conducted so that there is no segregation of the hot mix asphalt material during transport or placement of the mix. If segregation is observed by the Town, the paving operations will be suspended immediately. The Town may reject material, which appears to be defective based on visual inspection. Such rejected material shall not be used in the work and shall be removed and replaced by the Contractor at no cost to the Town.

(e) Testing

The Contractor will be responsible for providing compaction testing (including all testing costs), by a materials testing company approved by the Town, to determine the in-place density of the asphalt concrete. The asphalt concrete shall be compacted to a density of at least 92% but not greater than 98% of the theoretical maximum density from the plant. Tests shall be taken from a nuclear density gauge. Locations of the tests shall be determined by the Town. If the nuclear gauge testing presents failing results, the compaction of the asphalt concrete will be rejected and the Contractor shall remove and replace at no cost to the Town.

Price Adjustment

(f) This contract contains a Price Adjustment for Hot Mix Asphalt. The price adjustment will be based on the variance in price for the liquid asphalt component of Hot Mix Asphalt from the base price to the period price. It shall not include transportation or other charges. The <u>base price</u> of liquid asphalt on this project will be a fixed price based on the most current posted price for liquid asphalt as determined and published by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation. The <u>base price</u> for liquid asphalt on this project is \$\frac{505.00}{2}\$ per ton (June 2020 Adjustment Period).

The <u>period price</u> of liquid asphalt for a two month period will be determined by the current posted price as determined and published by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation. The year will be divided into six two month periods beginning July 1.

The price adjustment, as herein provided, upwards and downwards, will be made at the end of each two month period in which work was accomplished. The adjustment to cover the previous two months will be determined by the variance between the period price of liquid asphalt and the base price of liquid asphalt. The asphalt content, for the purpose of the adjustment will be 5.5% (0.055) for each ton of Hot Mix Asphalt, regardless of the percentages established in the Job Mix Formula. The <u>price adjustment</u> will be a separate payment item. It will be determined by multiplying the number of tons of Hot Mix Asphalt placed during each previous two month periods by (0.055) times the variance in price between base price and period price of liquid asphalt.

Method of Measurement

(g) Hot Mix Asphalt, Laid in Place shall be measured by the ton of actual material supplied.

Basis of Payment

(h) The Contractor will be paid the contract unit price per ton of actual material supplied, complete in place, which unit price shall include full compensation for all labor, materials, tools and equipment and all incidentals necessary to complete the work under this item as specified herein.

Additional Information:

- 1. Prevailing wage rates apply.
- 2. MassDOT Pre-Qualification Required.
- 3. Bid deposit of 5% of the value of the total bid will be required.
- 4. 100% payment and 100% performance bonds are required.

IV. QUALITY REQUIREMENTS

THIS CONTRACT is executed this day of , 2020 by and between:

hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor" and the TOWN OF WESTMINSTER, a municipal corporation duly organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, with a principal place of business at Town Hall, 11 South Street, Westminster, MA 01473, hereinafter referred to as the "Town", acting through its Public Works Commission.

The Town and the Contractor agree to the terms and conditions contained in this Contract and in the following documents which are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part hereof: Advertisement, bid document titled "Town of Westminster, Invitation for Bids, Hot Mix Asphalt, Laid in Place," Contractor's response to the Invitation for Bids, all addenda issued by the Town prior to and any modifications made by the Town subsequent to award of this Contract, certificate(s) of insurance and surety bond(s), if any, submitted in connection with this Project, and any duly authorized and executed amendments, change order or purchase orders issued by the town after execution of this Contract. Contractor agrees to perform the services indicated in its response to the Town's Invitation for Bids at the price indicated (\$) with price adjustment based on the New Method as determined and published by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation. The base price for liquid asphalt on this project is \$505.00 per ton, June 2020 Adjustment Period), and in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances and codes of the state, local and federal governments.

SCOPE OF WORK

The work shall consist of furnishing and applying Hot Mix Asphalt, Laid in Place to the Town of Westminster in accordance with the Invitation For Bid and this Specification. The bidder shall not subcontract any portion of this contract. The work to be done under this item shall consist of all the operations and furnishing all the materials, labor and equipment necessary to supply Hot Mix Asphalt, Laid in Place. The project quantity of Hot Mix Asphalt, Laid in Place is 10,000 TONS (Superpave 9.5 & 12.5mm Top, 19.0 & 37.5mm Binder). The bidder understands that the quantities stated are approximate and should not be interpreted as the actual quantities the Town will purchase or be committed to purchase.

MATERIALS

The Contractor agrees, unless otherwise specified, that all equipment, materials and supplies furnished under this contract are to be first quality, new and unused.

TERM OF CONTRACT

This Contract is effective when signed by both the Contractor and the Town, and shall extend for a period of one year. At the Town's sole discretion, this contract may be extended for two additional one year terms at the same contract price, terms and conditions.

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

The Town may, by written notice to the Contractor, terminate the whole or any part of this contract pursuant thereto in any one of the following circumstances:

- a) If, for any cause, the Contractor fails to fulfill in a timely manner its obligations under this Contract, or if the Contractor shall violate any of the covenants, agreements, or stipulations of this Contract, the Town shall thereupon have the right to terminate this Contract by giving written notice to the Contractor of such termination and specifying the effective date of such termination. Such notice shall be given not less than five (5) days prior to the effective date of termination and the Contractor shall be entitled to receive just and equitable compensation for any satisfactory work completed through the date of termination.
- b) If the Contractor fails to perform any of the other provisions of this contract or, if in the opinion of the Town, the Contractor so fails to make progress as to endanger performance of this contract in accordance with its terms, and in either of these two circumstances does not correct such failure within thirty (30) days (or such longer period as the Town may authorize in writing) after receipt of notice from the Town specifying such failure.

In the event of termination the Contractor shall have no right to payment for lost profits, consequential, incidental, indirect or punitive damages.

PREVAILING WAGE RATES

Minimum wage rates as determined by the Director of the Division of Occupational Safety under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 149, Sections 26-27 apply to this project. A copy of the wage schedule in effect for the duration of this project is attached to this Contract as Appendix A.

BID DEPOSIT

A 5% bid deposit of the value of the total bid is required.

PAYMENT BOND

A 100% payment bond is required.

PERFORMANCE BOND

A 100% performance bond is required.

PAYMENT TERMS

The Contractor shall provide the services at the price stated on the bid form and will be paid for work performed in accordance with the provisions contained in the Town of Westminster Invitation for Bids – Hot Mix Asphalt Laid in Place

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specifications of the Invitation for Bids and applicable state law. It is understood that payments under this contract shall not exceed the total contract price, unless the contract amount is increased by an authorized change order executed by the parties.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall secure and maintain for the duration of this project and at no cost to the Town, with respect to the services related to this Contract, insurance coverages for general, property, automobile, and workers' compensation as follows:

- a) General Liability on an occurrence basis with a total limit of at least \$1,000,000,
- b) Property Damage Liability on an occurrence basis with a limit per occurrence of at least \$1,000,000,
- c) Automobile Bodily Injury and Property Liability on an occurrence basis, with a limit per accident of at least \$500,000,
- d) Worker's Compensation, as required by law.

The Certificate Holder shall be identified as "Town of Westminster, Department of Public Works, 2 Oakmont Avenue, Westminster MA 01473." The Town of Westminster shall be named as an additional insured for the project.

WARRANTY

The Contractor agrees to warranty parts and labor for a period of one year from the date of acceptance of the project to the Town's full satisfaction. The Contractor shall replace, repair or make good, without cost to the Town, any defects or faults arising within one (1) year after date of acceptance of equipment, materials or supplies furnished hereunder (acceptance not to be unreasonably delayed) resulting from imperfect or defective work done or materials furnished by the Contractor.

AMENDMENTS/ALTERATIONS

This Contract shall not be amended or altered in any particular without the consent of all parties to this Contract. All alterations to this Contract must be in writing and authorized as such by the Chief Procurement Officer and the Contractor.

INDEMNIFICATION

The Contractor agrees to indemnify, save harmless, and defend the Town of Westminster and its respective employees, elected officials, agents, and assigns from and against any and all losses, liabilities, claims, penalties, suits and the cost and expense incident thereto, including the cost of defense, settlement and reasonable attorney's fees, which the Town may hereafter incur, become

responsible for, or pay out as a result of death or bodily injuries to any person, destruction or damage to any property, contamination of or any adverse effects on the environment or any violation of applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, bylaws, or ordinances to the extent caused by the contractor's breach of any term or provision of this agreement.

GOVERNING LAW

This contract shall be deemed to be a Massachusetts contract and its interpretation and construction shall be governed by the laws of Massachusetts and the Bylaws of the Town of Westminster.

SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Contract are severable. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Contract shall be finally adjudicated by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remainder of this Contract shall be unaffected by such adjudication and all of the remaining provisions of this Contract shall remain in full force and effect as though such section, paragraph, clause or provision, or any part thereof so adjudicated to be invalid had not been included herein, unless such remaining provisions, standing alone, are incomplete and incapable of being executed in accordance with the intent of the parties to this Contract.

In the event the Contractor is a corporation, a certificate that the person executing this contract is duly authorized to sign must accompany this contract.

This Contract shall become effective when signed by both the Contractor and the Town.

Notice to Drivers of BITUMINOUS CONCRETE

PREVAILING WAGE NOTICE

TO PUBLIC AWARDING AUTHORITIES AND CONTRACTORS

September 1, 2006

DRIVERS WHO HAUL BITUMINOUS CONCRETE (ASPHALT)

The Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court recently affirmed that drivers who haul bituminous concrete to public construction projects are not covered by the Prevailing Wage Law while offsite, including time spent over-the-road and picking-up materials. These drivers are covered by the Prevailing Wage Law only while on-site at the public construction project.

In <u>Teamsters Joint Council No. 10 v. Department of Labor, et al.</u>, 447 Mass. 100 (2006), the SJC upheld a 2001 administrative decision limiting the applicability of prevailing wage rates to the time bituminous drivers spend at the public construction site. This most recent decision of the SJC followed a 1989 ruling that had upheld an earlier Department of Labor (and Industries') policy that had deemed this category of drivers to be "teamsters" under the Law and, therefore, entitled to prevailing wage rates. <u>See Construction Industries of Massachusetts v. Commissioner of Labor and Industries</u>, 406 Mass. 162 (1989). However, the earlier court case had left open the question of whether this entitled these bituminous drivers to prevailing wage rates for their overthe-road time as well as their on-site time. This most recent decision has now answered that question.

All of the requirements of the Prevailing Wage Law, including certified weekly payroll requirements, apply to bituminous drivers for all time spent at the public construction site.

DRIVERS WHO HAUL READY-MIX CONCRETE (CEMENT)

Drivers who haul ready-mix concrete to public construction projects are not covered by the Prevailing Wage Law while off-site, including time spent over-the-road and picking-up materials. These drivers are covered by the Prevailing Wage Law while on-site at the public construction project. This applicability determination was established by a 2001 administrative decision of the Department of Labor's Division of Occupational Safety.

All of the requirements of the Prevailing Wage Law, including certified weekly payroll requirements, apply to ready-mix drivers for all time spent at the public construction site.

- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.
- All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
- Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.

A Payroll Form is available from the Department of Labor Standards (DLS) at www.mass.gov/dols/pw and includes all the information required to be kept by law. Every contractor or subcontractor is required to keep these records and preserve them for a period of three years from the date of completion of the contract.

On a weekly basis, every contractor and subcontractor is required to submit a certified copy of their weekly payroll records to the awarding authority; this includes the payroll forms and the Statement of Compliance form. The certified payroll records must be submitted either by regular mail or by e-mail to the awarding authority. Once collected, the awarding authority is required to preserve those records for three years from the date of completion of the project.

Each such contractor and subcontractor shall furnish weekly **and** within 15 days after completion of its portion of the work, to the awarding authority directly by first-class mail or e-mail, a statement, executed by the contractor, subcontractor or by any authorized officer thereof who supervised the payment of wages, this form, accompanied by their payroll:
